



**Information about the educational system:**

- ❖ Registration period: there is no registration period as the documents are automatically passed after the first registration.
- ❖ Exam period: The teaching year for students is divided into two (2) periods/semesters. The first lasts from 11<sup>th</sup> of September to 20<sup>th</sup> of January and the second lasts from 21<sup>st</sup> of January to 15<sup>th</sup> of June, approximately. Exams are conducted after the end of the second period/semester, during the May –June examination periods.
- ❖ School attendance policy
  - *number of absences: 114*
  - *reporting procedure of absences:* Each absence should be justified by parents (or by students themselves when they turn 18) and by specifying the reason. If a student has been home due to illness for more than 3 days, schools require a medical certificate
- ❖ Frequency of parent visits: At the end of each semesters, meetings teachers-parents are organised. Generally, parents can meet teachers and the rest school staff whenever they need.
- ❖ Public holidays:
  - Saturdays and Sundays,
  - October 28 (national holiday),
  - from 24 December to 7 January (Christmas break),
  - Clean Monday,
  - March 25 (national holiday),
  - from Monday until Friday of Easter Day (Easter holidays),
  - May 1st,
  - the Holy Spirit day,
  - from 22<sup>nd</sup> June to 31<sup>st</sup> August (summer holidays; for students until the 11<sup>th</sup> of September)
  - the day of the patron saint of the school seat and the day of the local national holiday
